


North Country CUSTOM SERIES

Charles River CUSTOM SERIES


Built on a stout frame of structural poplar and packed with 1" of polystyrene insulation, Charles River custom models feature time tested construction details. Overlays are affixed with industrial grade adhesive and screwed from the backside so no plugs, nails or fasteners show from the front. The beveled bottom rail ensures water runs off harmlessly. Its thoroughly engineered design produces the lightest, strongest and most weather resistant custom doors in the industry.





Morano BUILDER SERIES

Built on the same sturdy frame as the Charles River Series, craftsmen attach high quality, 1/4" plywood on both sides of the frame. Inside is 1" of polystyrene insulation creating an R value of 6. Paint grade overlay materials include Extira, a water resistant engineered wood, fine quality exterior grade plywood and Versatex, a bright white PVC that does not need to be painted. Stain grade materials include Meranti with marine grade plywood. Moranos are a great option for cost conscious consumers wanting a well constructed carriage door.



Allegheny River SEMI-CUSTOM SERIES



Material



DOUGLAS FIR is native to North America. It is known for its light rosy color and straight grain. Its color reddens over time when exposed to light. Designers appreciate its rich visual texture, grain pattern and its beautiful response to fine craftsmanship and finishing.



EXTIRA is a paint grade, non-structural, engineered wood product suitable for many environments. It is designed to resist damage from moisture, rot and insects. It is solid, dimensionally stable, free of knots or voids, and resists checking, splitting and cracking. Extira cannot be stained.



HEMLOCK is native to North America and is known for its fine texture, straight grain, and stiffness. Its color darkens only slightly with age and can be painted or stained.



MERANTI is a medium-to-coarse textured wood native to Southeast Asia. Meranti is one of a collection of species marketed as Philippine mahogany. Its light and dark red varieties produce ranges in color from pale pink to brown and reddish brown.



RADIATA PINE is native to California and is farmed extensively. It's natural color is pale yellow-brown and is generally straight grained. Compared to other pines, there is little contrast in the appearance of growth rings, contributing to its even and uniform texture.



SAPELE is known for its durability and beautiful graining. Native to Africa, the wood has a dark red brown color similar to mahogany. Sapele's excellent response to stain and its color, texture and grain make it a favorite among customers.



SPANISH CEDAR is a close relative of and resembles Honduras Mahogany. Its coloration is light red or pinkish orange with a straight, but wavy, grain. The wood has a moderately coarse texture. Its insect repelling resin adds to its durability but must be covered with tannin blockers prior to finishing.



VERSATEX is bright white cellular PVC that features the craftsmanship of wood without the moisture problems. It does not require painting or sealing and does not swell or rot. Its dense cell structure produces smoother edges, improved paint acceptance, less yellowing under sunlight and fewer dents and scuffs.



WESTERN RED CEDAR is an American wood with a soft red-brown color and a tight, straight grain with few knots. It can be finished to a smooth, silky surface with little effort. Lightest in weight, it is valued for its distinct appearance, aroma, and its high natural resistance to decay.

Finishing

Ask about factory finishing! Sikkens Door & Window products used for stained doors; Sherwin Williams products for painted doors. Extends the factory warranty by one year. Doors arrive ready to install.
